- Students and corporate cannot form combined teams during the online registration and submission phase.
- 4. The challenge will be open pan-India and the participating teams can submit their solutions to challenge(s) of their choice.

- 5. A team can submit only one solution per challenge. Solution once submitted cannot be changed. If you wish to amend the solution, then you need to resubmit the entire solution again.
- 6. A candidate cannot be a member of more than one team.
- 7. Once the solution has been submitted, team composition cannot be changed.

Prizes:

- 1. Each winning Team (Zonal Finals): Upto INR 70000
- 2. National Winning Team: Up to INR 150000
